Who can apply?

Compensation

- Pay is \$12.50 per hour up to 40 hours/week during the Initial Training Phase. The length of the training phase is dependent on how quickly you can complete the online coursework and progress to the Apprentice Inspector level based on approval by the Lead Inspector.
- Apprentice Inspectors earn an increased hourly rate and will continue to take coursework to progress to Lead Inspector. Length of this phase is dependent on how quickly you can complete coursework and meet benchmarks set by the lead inspector.
- Lead Inspectors earn an hourly rate starting at \$25 and based on experience and aptitude.
- Lead Inspectors receive an annual bonus based on performance throughout the year.
- Top home inspectors in the country earn between \$60,000 to \$70,000 per year. We believe in giving frequent feedback, opportunities for continuing education and reviews to ensure pay is commensurate with your growth as an inspector.
